Everyone is welcome to attend any Sensory Friendly

performance.

Time

The house doors open one hour before the performance.

We recommend arriving at least 30 minutes early.

Cost

All Sensory-Friendly Performances at the Tobin Center are provided at no cost to students, teachers, caregivers, and families thanks to generous contributions from The Najim Family Foundation and The Hearst Foundations. While there is no cost for this performance, tickets are required. They can be obtained <u>here</u>.

Parking

A parking garage is located off of Fourth Street for extra parking as needed. If you are being dropped off, there will be a drop-off zone at the front of the theatre. Ushers will be available to help you exit the car and enter the building.

Length of the Show

Sensory Friendly performances run approximately one hour.

Performance Hall Rules

Audience members are free to leave and come back into the HEB Performance Hall. Ushers will be located at each exit and entrance if you need help. There will also be extra room inside the performance hall for audience members to move around. The lights in the house will be on at a low level for safety.

Special Areas

A quiet space with calming sensory tools will be located in the Feik Family Rotunda. A movement space with sensory paths will be located in the lobby. A limited number of fidgets, sunglasses, and earplugs are available for use at the Sensory Supports Table. Please ask an usher for directions if you need help finding these areas.
